President Trump,

As Co-Chairs of the Congressional Caucus on Vietnam and Members of the United States House of Representatives who take an interest in human rights, we note with concern the designated venue for the second summit with North Korean leader, Kim Jong Un, in Hanoi, Vietnam. Being chosen to host a summit of this magnitude is an honor the Vietnamese government neither merits nor has earned, particularly given its deplorable human rights record, the detention of American citizens, and a new cybersecurity law that has already led to the censorship of social media posts from American and German citizens. We ask you to raise these issues in any discussion you may have with Vietnamese government and Communist Party leaders during your visit. They must not come away from the summit emboldened to expand restrictions on fundamental freedoms, but should know that the Administration views the status quo as unacceptable.

As you know, Vietnam has a disturbing record on human rights, particularly in the area of prisoners of conscience. In 2018, a list was released that included nearly 100 individuals who were imprisoned for holding views not tolerated by the Vietnamese government. The treatment endured by these prisoners is also alarming. American citizens have been arrested and reportedly brutally beaten during visits to Vietnam and Michael Phuong Minh Nguyen remains detained on trumped up charges since July 7, 2018. We ask you to make his case a priority during your visit to signal that the Vietnamese government's actions are unacceptable.

Human rights conditions in Vietnam are a high priority to us and our constituents and we believe that concrete improvements are intimately connected to U.S. interests and desired by the majority of the Vietnamese people. Therefore, if you cannot reconsider the venue of the North Korea summit, we ask that you meet with Vietnamese leaders and make the case why substantive improvements in the protections of religious freedom, free speech, and other basic human rights are a prerequisite for enhanced U.S.-Vietnam relations. We also ask that you strongly push for the release of Michael Phuong Minh Nguyen and the unconditional release of all prisoners of conscience. We have enclosed a list of prisoner cases we ask you to raise.

We look forward to hearing from you.
